Volunteering

Volunteers help with data entry and administration support, and work as Information and Support Workers providing information, referrals, advocacy and other forms of material aid to clients in need. Full training is provided for half or full day ongoing volunteering on a roster basis.

Keeping It Together

The aim of the Keeping It Together Program is about strengthening families and helping to prevent family breakdown. An 8 week program provides women with the opportunity to improve their basic skills of communication, assertiveness, conflict resolution, understanding and working with anger, enhancing their awareness of self-esteem issues and the importance of self-care. The sessions go for 2 hours and are run in different areas in Casey and Cardinia.



Casey North Community Information & Support Service (CNCISS) provides a range of support programs and information services, staffed by both professional workers and trained volunteers. All services provided are free and confidential. Areas covered vary from program to program, see below;

Emergency Relief

Assistance provided to households in severe financial hardship and unable to purchase essential items such as food, medicine and other essential services. Shower packs and vouchers also available for the homeless.

Support Program

Social Work/Case Work

Provides support to people in crisis or needing assistance with complex issues.

No Interest Loan Scheme

Casey NILS enables eligible people on low incomes to apply for a loan of up to \$2,000 to purchase essential household items, pay some medical expenses, help toward education costs, purchase tyres, pay for car repairs or registration, and to pay for bond and rent in advance for new rentals. There are never any fees or charges, and affordable repayments are made over 12 - 24 months.
